

**INFANT HAT INSTRUCTIONS  
PURPLE YARN**

**Size 1 Needle  
5” in length**

**Cast on (80) stitches. Work in \*TK2 and P2 across the row, slipping the first stitch of this row and each succeeding row, including the decrease rows.**

**Continue in TK2, P2 until piece measures 7”**

**DECREASE FOR TOP**

**FIRST DECREASE ROW:**

- \*TK2, P2 tog across. Work even for 3 rows, twist-knitting the TK stitches and purling the purl stitches continuing in the established rib pattern.

**SECOND DECREASE ROW:**

- TK2 together, P1 across. Work even for 3 rows, twist-knitting the TK stitches and purling the purl stitches continuing in the established rib pattern.

**THIRD DECREASE ROW:**

- TK2 together across. Purl one row.

**LAST DECREASE ROW:**

- TK2 together across.
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**Leave about a yard long tail and break the yarn. Thread the tail through a darning needle, pull the yarn through the stitches left on the knitting needle, then remove the knitting needle.**

**Draw the stitches tight. With right sides together, sew a seam to within 2 inches of the bottom of the hat. Turn. With wrong sides together, finish the seam. This will keep the seam from showing on the turned up brim.**

**TK = twisted knit (knit in back of knit stitch instead of front)**

**For a looser knit hat, use larger needles and adjust stitches accordingly. Always knit a swatch first.**
